

KEY APOSTOLIC PRAYERS – COREY STARK

1. For revelation of God’s beauty that we might walk in our calling and destiny by God’s power.

Eph. 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power...

2. To receive the Spirit’s power to experience greater intimacy with Jesus and maturity by His love.

Eph. 3:14 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵ from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, ¹⁶ that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷ that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— ¹⁹ to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

3. For God’s love to abound in us by the knowledge of God, resulting in righteousness in our life.

Phil. 1:9 This I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, ¹⁰ that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ ¹¹ being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

4. To know God’s will, to be fruitful in ministry and strengthened by intimacy with Him.

Col. 1:9 For this reason we... do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; ¹⁰ that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; ¹¹ strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; ¹² giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.

5. For more of God’s Spirit, resulting in greater revelation (dreams, visions, prophecy) and salvations.

Acts 2:17 In the last days, says God, I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams... ¹⁹ I will show wonders in heaven above and signs in the earth beneath: blood and fire and vapor of smoke. ²⁰ The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. ²¹ And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

6. For impartation of boldness (singing/speaking the Word) by releasing healing, signs and wonders.

Acts 4:24 They raised their voice to God with one accord and said: “Lord, You are God, who made heaven and earth... and all that is in them... ²⁹ Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, ³⁰ by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.” ³¹ When they had prayed, the place where they were assembled was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and spoke the word of God with boldness.

7. To be filled with supernatural joy and peace with confidence, causing the overflow of divine hope.

Rom. 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

8. To bring glory to God through citywide Church unity by receiving one another with Jesus love.

Rom. 15:5 Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, 6 that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. 7 Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

9. To be enriched by all spiritual gifts unto powerful preaching, prophetic revelation and holiness.

1 Cor. 1:4 I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus, 5 that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge, 6 even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you, 7 so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, 8 who will also confirm you to the end, that you may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

10. For the release of grace to bring the Church to maturity, especially to abound in love and holiness.

1 Thes. 3:11 Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way to you. 12 And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you, 13 so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.

11. To be worthy (made spiritually mature) to walk in the fullness of our identity and destiny in God.

2 Thes. 1:11 We also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, 12 that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

12. For the Word to increase its influence (effectiveness) in the city, as God releases His power on it.

2 Thes. 3:1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified, just as it is with you, 2 and that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith. 3 But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one. 4 And we have confidence in the Lord concerning you, both that you do and will do the things we command you. 5 Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ.

13. Prayer for Israel's salvation and one new man to emerge, comprised of Jews & Gentiles (Eph. 2:15).

Rom. 10:1 My heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.
